I have lived in Minneapolis for the past 43 years. I currently reside in the Corcoran community in South Minneapolis with my wife and seven children. I am a part-time associate pastor at Vine Church in South Minneapolis as well as I have the privilege of working as a part-time middle school Bible teacher at Hope Academy. I love both of my jobs.

In the black community where I was raised, abortion was/is a common practice. When I realized that my friends and family members were having abortions, many at young ages, I knew I wanted to do my part to

help ensure women had access to life-affirming options, thereby minimizing the (perceived) need for abortion. I believe that everyone deserves to know that God values all life. I also believe that everyone deserves to know that God is a merciful and forgiving God, regardless of past decisions.



new life

A woman who had used drugs during her pregnancy came in for an ultrasound, and was strongly considering abortion. A few months later, thinking she was calling an abortion clinic, she accidentally dialed New Life Adoptions instead! After processing her situation with one of our social workers over several calls, she decided to continue her pregnancy. We didn't hear from her for several months, then we received a call from the hospital stating she and the birth father wanted to make an adoption plan. They asked us to choose the family that would raise their child.

The adoptive family we chose originally came to us through pursuing embryo adoption. Unfortunately, their multiple attempts of embryo adoption were unsuccessful. They then turned to traditional adoption and had been waiting more than two years when they "got the call." We asked if they were open to this situation, and they quickly said yes! Everything happened rather quickly, and they brought their new baby home the next week. They have an open adoption relationship with some ongoing contact with the birth family and we are so grateful to be a part of their story!

STORIES OF IMPACT



While much of the Every Family program consists of oneon-one parenting coaching sessions, what many don't know is that we also offer group classes in both English and Spanish. Our group classes offer a unique way of building communal support and engagement by walking through the curriculum. As our Client Advocate, Kenzie, emphasized, "Having the curriculum in a group context helps strip away some of that shame for parents, helping them to see that their struggles are normal and relatable to others."

As friendships develop and phone numbers are swapped, group classes foster natural mentorship among participants. Those with more parenting experience take pride in coming alongside new parents to share from their own experiences, mistakes, and wisdom. For other group members, it offers a place to swap advice and stories on adjusting to life in America. One parent exclaimed, "Coming here and going through Every Family didn't just help me with parenting— it helped me in my relationship with my husband!" It is our hope that the group classes we offer would continue to grow and be a place of comfort, deep connection, and lasting friendship for all involved.



It is such a blessing to witness God working through the Conquerors ministry. Here is one such story. A woman from a recent Conquerors group was processing two abortions she had many years ago. While her husband was not the father of these children, he was very supportive of her going through the program. As we were nearing the memorial service week, she wasn't sure if she would ask her husband to attend since this wasn't something they shared together. After much prayer, she asked if he would attend and he lovingly agreed. On the day of the memorial, she was able to grieve, honor those lives and rest in God's complete forgiveness. After the service, her husband became emotional and shared how deeply powerful the service was. He shared how he could see that God was present throughout, how deeply touched he was by the reminder of God's love and that there is hope and forgiveness for us all.


While she initially felt like she might have to go it alone, there they were, together in awe of God and his amazing grace. We are blessed and honored that God allows us a peek into sweet moments like this. All for God's glory!



Seven years ago, Millie visited one of our centers frustrated, scared, and unsure of what to do with her pregnancy. She already tried reaching out to others but didn't feel seen or heard. Our social worker listened with empathy while she cried and shared her concerns, and offered prayers of peace. After a few more meetings, Millie decided to continue her pregnancy and, eventually, parent her son.

Millie, now a mom of two and expecting her third child, recently came back into one of our centers and shared her struggles, difficulties, and joys of being a parent. She said that despite the challenges, it's her love for her children that keeps her pushing forward when she wants to give up. "I don't think I would have parented my son if I hadn't come here," she told us. "This is my village. Whenever I come here I know I will be listened to."

It is a privilege to be invited into these situations with our clients. These women and families (and their experiences) give our staff the motivation and determination to show up every day to make sure that all who walk through our doors feel valued, supported, and heard.

MINNEAPOLIS CENTER IN THE PHILLIPS NEIGHBORHOOD

It was nine years ago that we felt a prompting from the Lord to add a fifth center location and began praying for what would become this new First Care center. While there have been many bumps and steps of faith along the way, we are so grateful for the Lord's timing.

We never imagined owning property, let alone building a facility from the ground up. However, isn't it just like God to take our tiny vision and turn it into something far greater than we could have even imagined? **We have built a**12,600 square foot facility that will not only house our largest pregnancy center, but also a full-service medical clinic offering prenatal care and whole family care for our clients and the community at large!

One of the greatest joys of this journey has been meeting Dr. Odam and his wife Abena, and hearing about how they were already serving the Phillips community in a way that resonated with our heart and mission. One of the things that impressed us immediately was that they had large family exam rooms, where a single mom could come with all of her children to be seen at once. They were proactively eliminating barriers that families face

in receiving needed health care. It was truly a Godmoment when we recognized our alignment, and how our facility could be so much greater than we had ever imagined!

While we have built connections and partnerships in the Phillips neighborhood over the past several years, we are excited for the opportunity to have a physical presence and to become a permanent part of the fabric of this neighborhood. It is a community with such cultural richness, strong roots that tie it together, and incredible resilience. We know there are (and will be) significant challenges, but we are honored to be able to come alongside the women, men, children and families in the Phillips community, as our goal has always been to help families thrive!

Tell us a little bit about yourself:

My name is Erin Busse. My husband Mark and I have a nine year old daughter and a six year old son. I am a former teacher and now, in addition to parenting, I am a part-time paraprofessional, part-time nanny, and I have been a volunteer Parenting Coach since 2019! I love it all.

Why did you get involved with New Life?

Thriving families are God's design to model his love, and to send forth adults who are ready to love the next generation. God works powerfully through families and New Life is a place that speaks hope, life, and dignity to all people.

What made you want to be a coach?

Being a mom is the best and the hardest, and I was blessed to have other women on that journey with me. Now I get to be a part of providing that community for other women. I want to be a part of helping moms choose life. It's the body of Christ in action.

How has your mindset/heart changed since becoming a coach?

I've been very humbled—and grateful—to learn that coaching is all about connection and relationship, not having the right answers. I've also experienced a deep conviction to share the gospel when I have that opportunity! If I really believe Jesus changes lives and futures — and I do — then I cannot let an opportunity go by that I don't point to Him as the answer.

Can you tell about a really memorable coaching interaction you have had with a client?

One time we were discussing gifts gone awry in kids, or negative behaviors children have that are actually signs of a positive virtue (e.g.: stubbornness harnessed for good can be resiliency!). This mom was at the end of her rope with one of her children's behaviors, but she was able to see her child in a whole new light during that lesson. She was filled with appreciation, love and hope for her child's future and how God made them. I was able to pray for her child and she left excited about who her child was, and she felt equipped to parent that child. It was amazing.

What impact have our clients had on you?

Many of our clients are pressing on in the face of really tough circumstances, and I'm moved by their grit and grateful they let me into their lives. I see God working, drawing many clients closer to Him, and answering prayers. I've also seen that parents know what's best for their children.

What advice would you give others who might be interested in volunteering?

Come and check it out! It's one of my favorite things I've ever done. With the awesome way New Life prepares you, you will be able to go in to coaching sessions feeling ready and excited. Just as every client is unique, so is every coach. You could bring something to coaching that is uniquely you, and God will use it to help families thrive.
