The Social Work Intern position helps fulfill New Life Family Services' mission of assisting clients in life-affirming decisions with the love and compassion of Christ by providing quality services related to those seeking pregnancy and parenting support.

Location: First Care Centers, Twin Cities

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide direct services to individuals seeking pregnancy tests.
- Provide decision making counseling and alternatives for clients including abortion procedures and risks, parenting information, and adoption education as appropriate during pregnancy test appointments.
- Provide individual and group parent education and coaching sessions with clients through use of approved curriculum.
- Provide resources and referrals as appropriate. Connect clients with Client Care Workers for additional support as needed.
- Provide referrals and coordination of services for other assessed needs.
- Maintain accurate records of services provided according to agency standards.
- Work closely with Client Care staff to provide continuity of care.
- Assist Client Care staff in administrative projects as assigned.

POSITION QUALIFICATIONS

- Pursuing Bachelor's Degree in Social Work.
- Ability to take direction from supervisor, work as part of a team, but also independently.
