Nearly 40 years ago, Cathy found hope when she thought she had lost her chance to be a mother. Cathy had three abortions before age twenty-five, believing the lie that her pregnancies were simply formless tissue. After getting married a few years later, Cathy learned that she was unable to have more children due to the impact her abortions had on her body.

> As Cathy and her husband began studying the Bible together, she started to feel convicted about her abortions. Through studying God's word, she repented and came to understand and receive the incredible grace and forgiveness of God. She finally understood that her infertility was not a punishment—it was God's way of leading them to their daughter!





Story of Hope: A 1980s New Life Story

In the 1980s, Cathy and her husband discovered New Life Homes (now called New Life Family Services) and began the adoption process. Cathy described adopting their baby girl as finally experiencing God's redemption over her past abortions. He made her a mother when it seemed impossible.


